Large Country Projects - Lending

RUSSIAN FEDERATION – STASYS Project

- Improvement of organization, management strategy, and perspective planning
- Fostering knowledge of standards and methodology
- Strengthening of statistical infrastructure
- Reorganization of data collection, processing and dissemination
- Introduction and compilation of financial statistics
- Improvement of coverage and quality of BOP statistics
- Improvement of the capabilities of the Government in utilization of statistical information used for economic monitoring, forecasting and policy-making
- Improvement of vital statistics processing
- Project management



Large Country Projects – Lending (cont.)

RUSSIAN FEDERATION – STASYS 2 Project

- Modernization of economic statistics methodology
- *Development of modern design and technology for statistical data collection, processing, and dissemination system*
- Enhancement of social statistics
- Human resource development
- Project Management



Large Country Projects – Lending (cont.)

- India
- WB support to home grown statistical reform in India. National Strategic Statistical Plan (NSSP) for strengthening the statistical systems in states and UTs within a national policy framework.
- India Statistical Strengthening Project (ISSP) – a comprehensive program to implement the NSSP through the centrally sponsored scheme (CSS) under XIth Five year Plan.
- DPL as an instrument to support the Government of India (GoI) institutional reform and capacity building in statistics – 80% has been funded through the World Bank loan and 20% by the GoI. The best choice of instrument at the time.



Large Country Projects – Lending (cont.)

India

The SSL was designed to support integration of all states/UTs into a coordinated national statistical system and continued improvement in the quality of key statistics at state level through supporting the activities in four policy areas

Coordination and Leadership

- Increasing Support from Center to States
- Strengthening the Capacity and Performance of State Statistical Systems
- Improving the Coverage, Quality, Timeliness and Credibility of Statistics Generated by States and UTs



Statistics for Results Facility

- Finances country projects up to 10 million dollars
- Pilot countries – Afghanistan, DRC, Ghana, Nigeria and Rwanda
- Added into pilot – Ethiopia, Senegal, Lao
- Donor participation
- Design of projects
- Some lessons learned



ECASTAT

- Regional Programs
 - Improvement in agricultural statistics
 - Improvement in labor statistics
 - Data visualization and dissemination
- Country Programs
 - NSDS implementation
 - Design follows STATCAP project design
- Both types of programs financed in one facility
